## OPERATING MODES

When the power is connected, toggle the switch to enter different modes and perform corresponding operations. There are three working modes:



Set Mode

Normal Mode

Lock Mode

**Set Mode:** Toggle the switch to Set position, the device will be in the setting state and displays the time and function icons only.

**Functions:** Set the time (including time adjustment and 12/24-hour clock), countdown / wake up / sleep / play (including the duration, sound effect, light colour, and light on prior to alarm time).

**Normal Mode:** Toggle the switch to Normal position, the device will be in normal state that displays the time, facial expression and the function icons. You can turn on / off / delay the functions of a countdown, wake up, fall asleep and play or adjust the display brightness, alarm volume, and indicator brightness.

**Child Lock Mode:** Toggle the switch to Lock position to lock the alarm clock. Only the facial expression appears on the display in this mode. The function keys will only work for volume, display brightness, and snooze (night light).


You can set multiple groups of alarms through the app and turn them on or off through the app with a press of any function key. Only one alarm can be set through physical keys.

## QUICK START GUIDE IN NORMAL MODE

### DISPLAY BRIGHTNESS ADJUSTMENT

1. Press  to adjust or turn off the brightness.





### WAKE UP FUNCTION

1. ON: Press , the wake-up time displays; the  icon will flash for three seconds and then the display returns to the normal time display.
2. OFF: Press  again, and the  icon disappears.





### PLAY FUNCTION

1. ON: Press , the play time displays; the  icon flashes for three seconds and then the display returns to normal time display.
2. OFF: Press  again, and the  icon disappears.



### NAP FUNCTION

1. Start: Press , the countdown starts and the  icon appears.
2. Stop: Press  again, the countdown stops and the  icon disappears.

### FALL-ASLEEP FUNCTION

1. ON: Press , the fall-asleep time displays; the  flashes for three seconds and then the display returns to the normal time display.
2. OFF: Press  again, and the  icon disappears.

## SNOOZE FUNCTION





1. When no alarm is triggered: Press  to turn on or off the light.
2. When the alarm starts sounding: Press  to delay the alarm.

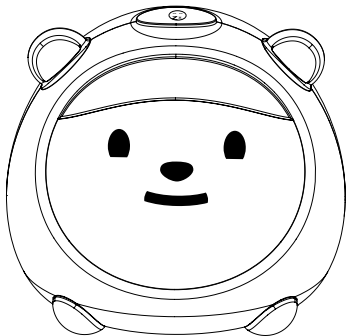

## QUICK START GUIDE IN LOCK MODE



The facial expression and the corresponding indicator light will be displayed in Lock mode. When Lock mode is enabled, the function keys will not work except for the following features: volume, display brightness, and snooze (night light).



1. When the alarm starts sounding: Press to delay the alarm; press the / to adjust the volume, and press / to adjust the brightness.
2. When no alarm is triggered: Press to turn the indicator light on or off.

**Note:** The facial expressions shown are in default state; you can customise the facial expression through the app.

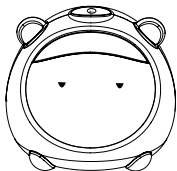

## APP OPERATIONS

### DOWNLOAD APP

Download Pixbee 'Smart Life' from App Store/ Google Play or Scan the QR code, sign up and log in.



### MOBILE PHONE CONNECT TO 2.4GHZ WIFI

**Connect your smart phone to a 2.4 GHz WiFi network during setup**

1. If you're connecting your Pixbee Nest Smart Alarm Clock directly to your router's WiFi network, it's important to understand that your smart phone must connect to the same WiFi network as the alarm clock during setup.

**Note:** Once the alarm clock is successfully connected to WiFi, your phone can use other networks at will, without having to be connected to the same WiFi as the alarm clock.

2. Your alarm clock can only connect to a 2.4 GHz WiFi network. Many routers broadcast WiFi networks in both 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz bands, so your phone might connect to the 5 GHz WiFi band. During setup, connect your phone to your 2.4 GHz WiFi network, then connect your Kids' Alarm Clock to that same 2.4 GHz WiFi network.

## Find your 2.4 GHz WiFi network name and password

Your phone might connect to your 5 GHz WiFi network most of the time. If you're not sure about how to find the 2.4 GHz WiFi network:

1. Look on your WiFi router label.

Many routers have a label that shows the WiFi network name, which is also called an SSID.

Your 2.4 GHz network name might have a 2, 2.4, or 2G at the end. Your 5 GHz network name might have a 5 or 5G at the end. If you changed your WiFi settings, then check the place where you saved your custom settings.

2. If your WiFi network name or SSID doesn't indicate whether it's 2.4 GHz or 5 GHz, ask your internet service provider (ISP) or the person who set up your WiFi router or refer to the video below to find the answer by scanning the QR code..

## Connect your phone to a 2.4 GHz network

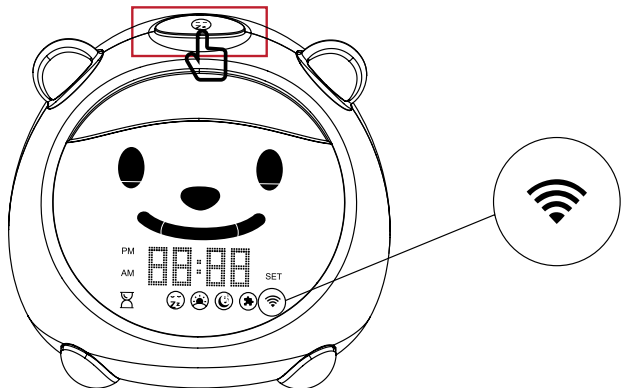
1. Turn on your phone's WiFi.
2. Select a 2.4 GHz WiFi network.

This is commonly indicated by a 2, 2.4, or 2G at the end of the network name.

3. If prompted, enter the password for the network.

## ENTER ALARM CLOCK INTO WIFI CONNECTING MODE INTO WIFI CONNECTING MODE

1. Plug in to power, the flashing  indicates the device is now under WiFi connecting mode.
2. If  stays solid or hidden, long-press  till  flashes to enter WiFi connecting mode.

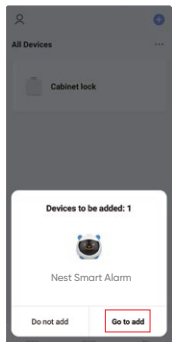


## CONNECT DEVICE TO APP

### Note:

1. Turn on GPS location, WiFi (2.4 GHz only) and bluetooth on your smartphone before connecting device to your WiFi (2.4GHz only).
2. Make sure the alarm clock has entered the **WiFi Connecting Mode** (please refer to the previous point - **Make Alarm Clock Enter into WiFi Connecting Mode**) - the flashing WiFi icon shows the device is ready to connect to WiFi (2.4GHz only).

1. Open up Pixbee Smart Life app, Click on **Go to add**.



2. If the add page does not pop up, click **Add Device**.



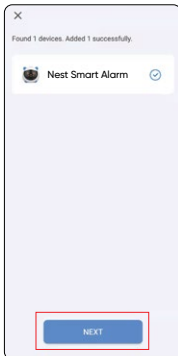

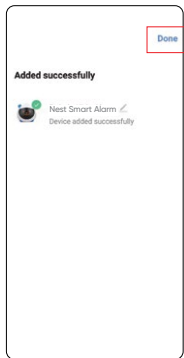
4. Type in the 2.4 GHz WiFi password and click on **Next** (make sure the smartphone and Smart Life app are both connected to 2.4 GHz WiFi).



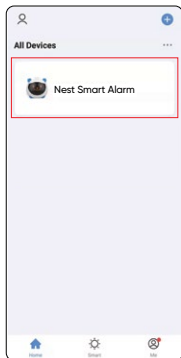
5. After the device has successfully connected to your 2.4GHz WiFi, click **Next**;



6. You can re-name the device after it has successfully connected to your 2.4 GHz WiFi, click on **Done** to complete the WiFi setup process.



7. You can see the added device, click **Nest Smart Alarm** enter to Home Page.

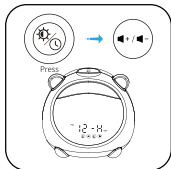
## TIME AND 12/24-HOUR CLOCK






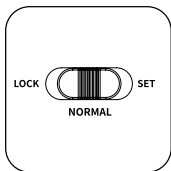
1. Toggle the switch to the Set setting mode, press  to set the time. The 'hour' flashes in the display, adjust the hour by pressing .



2. Press  to enter the minute setting. The 'minute' flashes in the display, adjust the minute by pressing .





3. Press  to enter the 12/24-hour clock setting, the '12-H' flashes in the display; select 12H/24h by pressing , and then press  to complete the setting.

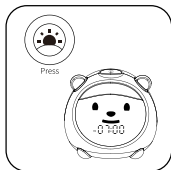

## CAUTION

- Place the product on a stable, flat, and non-slip surface.
- Do not disassemble the product as it is composed of fragile components.
- Do not use the product in rooms where the temperature is below 0°C or above 40°C.
- Only clean the alarm clock with a soft and dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleansers, cleansing pads or cleansers such as alcohol or acetone, as this may damage the surface of the product.



**CAUTION:** Lithium button /coin cell batteries are hazardous whether new or used! Keep batteries away from children. If swallowed or placed inside any part of the body, batteries can cause severe or fatal injuries in 2 hours or less. Seek immediate medical attention if suspected.

Any replacement of the internal battery is intended to be made by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified person.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### 1. Why can't I turn the alarm clock on?

Connect the adapter to activate the alarm clock for the first use.

### 2. Does the alarm clock need to be connected to the adapter all the time to work?

The Pixbee Nest Smart Alarm Clock does not have a built-in battery so it needs to be connected to a power supply via USB all the time.

### 3. Why didn't the alarm go off?

Check the display to confirm there is a wake up alarm icon in the normal mode. Then press the wake up alarm button to check if the set alarm time is correct and if the volume is set to S-00.



### 4. Can the light colour be changed?

The light colour in wake-up/fall-asleep/nap mode cannot be changed, you can only turn on or off the light. The play mode has a changing colourful light, you can also turn this light on or off.

### 5. How many kinds of sound effects are there and can I change it?

There are ten choices of built-in sound effects, including four fall-asleep sounds, two wake-up sounds, two play sounds, and two countdown sounds. The built-in sound effects can't be changed.

### 6. Can I adjust the volume?

There are ten levels of sound volume. You can press +/- to adjust the it when the alarm rings. The default sound volume cannot be changed.

## **WARRANTY TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

This warranty is provided in addition to your rights under the Australian Consumer Law. Directed Electronics Australia Pty Ltd (Directed Electronics) warrants that this product is free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 12 months from the date of purchase or for the period stated on the packaging. This warranty is only valid where you have used the product in accordance with any recommendations or instructions provided by Directed Electronics.

This warranty excludes defects resulting from alterations of the product, accident, misuse, abuse or neglect. To claim the warranty, you must return the product to the retailer from which it was purchased or if that retailer is part of a National network, a store within that chain, along with satisfactory proof of purchase. The retailer will then return the goods to Directed Electronics.
